

# Gift Aid your TotSoc subscription

TotSoc is resurrecting its gift-aid scheme so that subscriptions from members who are taxpayers can be used to generate additional funds to support the society. Many members completed gift-aid forms some years ago, but unfortunately these records have not seen the light of day in recent times. We are therefore now asking all members who are taxpayers to kindly complete a new gift-aid form (see below). If you attended the recent AGM or have joined TotSoc in recent months, you will already have been encouraged to do this.

### NOTES

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains tax equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local tax office.
